**Class Title:** Woodworking Safety Certification Class– Session 1

**Description:** This class is for those who have had experience with **all** the power tools of woodworking and are familiar with the setup and operation of the power tools in a well-equipped workshop, but who wish to learn how to work more safely. For those just starting out in woodworking or those that need further review on just a few of the power tools, it is strongly suggested that you sign up for and complete the Using Power Tools for Woodworking course. In

the Safety Certification Class students will review safety standards and safe operating procedures for the table saw, miter saw, bandsaw, planer, jointer, router, router table, drill press, mortiser, and various power sanders. Individuals who take this class **and** pass optional written and practical exams will qualify for the Level 1 Woodworker Certification. This certification is a prerequisite to scheduling time in our Independent Skill Development program here at the CU Woodshop School of Woodworking. Once certified the students will gain access to the tools and machinery at the school to perfect their woodworking skills and construct their own projects.
