

Stickley Tall Clock

Description: This clock was originally designed by L & JG Stickley circa 1910. Originals lately have sold for \$50,000 to \$70,000. The original clock is housed at the historic Stickley Craftsman Farm in New Jersey.

Stickley reproductions sell at fine furniture stores for over \$6,500. Building the Tall Clock will require a great deal of hard work. You will be building a family heirloom that will last for generations. The clock is made from beautiful quarter-sawn white oak and has a high quality movement. This design features classic Stickley craftsmanship. In our 5 day class you will learn about mortise and tenon techniques, frame and panel construction, building door and the secrets of fitting them in the case. We will cover finishing techniques and installation of clock components and hardware. You will have a great sense of accomplishment after building this clock, and have more confidence in building your next furniture project.
