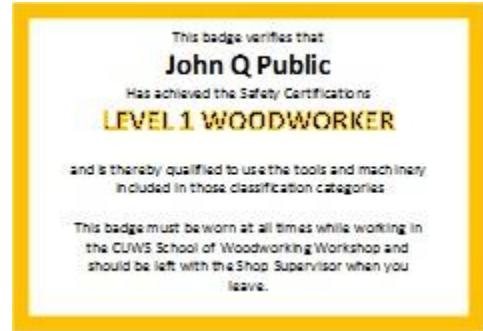


Woodworking Safety (Parkland Class)

Description: This class is for those who have had some experience in woodworking and are familiar with the basic setup and operation of the power tools in a well-equipped workshop, but who wish to learn how to work more safely. Students will review safety standards and safe operating procedures for the table saw, miter saw, bandsaw, planer, jointer, router, router table, drill press, mortiser, and various power sanders. Individuals who take this class and pass optional written and practical exams will qualify for the Level 1 Woodworker Certification, which is a prerequisite to scheduling Independent Skill Development in the CU Woodshop School of Woodworking and to utilize the tools and machinery in that workshop to perfect their woodworking skills and construct their own projects.
